



## CHESS

### REGULATIONS

#### TIME

The chess tournament will take place from May 19th to May 20st.

#### PLACE

University of Tartu Sports Hall, Institution of Sports Sciences and Physiotherapy, room 3014 (Ujula 4, Tartu).

#### REGISTRATION

According to SELL 2023 General Regulations.

#### PARTICIPANTS

Each University team can register up to 5 participants in Men's category and up to 3 participants in the Women's category;

Participants must have a FIDE ID number, which is registered by the National Chess Federations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1) The exact tournament system, draw and timetable will be published after the registration. In total 3 sets of medals - Men's category, Women's category and Teams category will be awarded;
- 2) Individual Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules, FIDE ELO rated (rapid);
- 3) Time control: 15 minutes per game per player + 10 seconds per move starting from move 1;
- 4) The latest version of the Swiss Manager software will be used for pairings and results determination. Representatives of the same University teams will not be paired against each other;
- 5) The default time in case of late arrival (no appearance) is 15 minutes.

## PRIZES AND TIE-BREAKS

- 1) The first three winners in the Men's, Women's and Teams categories will be awarded medals and diplomas;
- 2) The University teams results are determined by adding up the sum of the points obtained by the best two results of the University representatives in the Men's category and the best results by the University representative in the Women's category;
- 3) Tie-breaks in the Men's and Women's categories are as follows:
- 4) Bucholz- 1;
- 5) Bucholz;
- 6) Rating Performance;
- 7) Tie-breaks in the teams' categories are as follows:
- 8) The sum of the places taken in the tournament of two best University representatives in the Men's category and one best University representative in the Women's category (the lowest sum wins);
- 9) The sum of the individual tie-breaks of two best University representatives in the Men's category and one best University representative in the Women's category.
