### REGULATIONS

#### SCHEDULE

19 to 21 May 2023.

#### LOCATION

19 & 20 May A.Le Coq Sports Hall (Ihaste tee 7, Tartu).

21 May (finals) University of Tartu Sports Hall (Ujula 4, Tartu).

#### REGISTRATION

According to SELL Games 2023 general regulations.  
Each university can register one male and one female team.

#### PARTICIPANTS

Everyone who qualifies according to the SELL Games 2023 general regulations can participate.

Each team can consist of maximum 14 athletes and 4 officials.

Team registration form must be submitted at the latest 18th of May.

Exact team roster must be confirmed at the latest 30 minutes before each game.

Team roster:

14 players - 12+2 libero

13 players - 11+2 libero

12 players - 10+2 libero / 11+1 libero / 12+0 libero

11 players - 9+2 libero / 10+1 libero / 11+0 libero

10 players - 8+2 libero / 9+1 libero / 10+0 libero

9 players - 7+2 libero / 8+1 libero / 9+0 libero

8 players - 7+1 libero / 6+2 libero / 8+0 libero

7 players - 6+1 libero / 7+0 libero

6 players - 6+0 libero

#### COMPETITION SYSTEM

The exact competition system and schedule will be provided after the latest registration.  
Competition is held in accordance to FIVB rules.

Tournament is held in group stages and play-offs.

In group stages (2-0) win will grant 3 points, (2-1) win will grant 2 points, (1-2) lose will grant 1 point, (0-2) lose and forfeit will grant 0 points.



Group stage ranking will be decided as follows:

- 1) Amount of wins.
- 2) Amount of points.
- 3) WON/LOST games.
- 4) WON/LOST game points.

All matches are played until 2 games have been won. Each game is played until 25 points (with a 2 point difference) and if necessary, third game is played until 15 points. All exceptions that are not mentioned in the regulations will be solved during the competition by the head referee.

All protests will be handled in accordance to SELL Games 2023 general regulations.
